Function
<p>Macomb County Community Corrections is a community based punishment and rehabilitative program aimed at relieving prison and jail overcrowding through Court-approved sentencing alternatives. Non-violent offenders are placed into community sanctions, rather than in jail or prison, to free-up corrections space for more serious offenders. Rehabilitative and monitoring options include substance abuse inpatient and outpatient treatment, daily reporting services, urine testing, community service work, job training assistance, cognitive restructuring and pre-trial release supervision.</p> <p>If a county wishes to apply for funding and other assistance under the Department of Corrections – Community Corrections Act, then MCL 791.406 requires the creation of this Advisory Board.</p> <p>There is no statutorily mandated compensation for these Board members and no payments are being made at this time.</p>

Membership Composition:

- One member shall be the county sheriff (duration of term of office)
- One member shall be a chief of a city police department
- One member shall be a judge of the circuit court
- One member shall be a judge of the district court
- One member shall be a judge of the probate court
- One member shall be a county commissioner (2 years)
- One member shall be a member of city government (2 years)
- One member shall represent an existing community alternative program (2 years)
- One member shall be the director of the department of corrections (3 years)
- One member shall be a county prosecutor (duration of term of office)
- One member shall be a criminal defense attorney (2 years)
- One member shall be from the business community (2 Years)
- One member shall be from the communications media (2Years)

The first term of service for Judges is 4 years; the first term of service for Police Chief, CC Probation Agent, Program Representative is 3 years; County Commissioner, Criminal Defense Attorney, Communications Media, Business Community, and Public Representatives is 2 years.

Thereafter the terms for all board members except Sheriff and Prosecutor are 3 years in duration or until a successor is appointed.

Term: 5 years, (maximum of 10 years)
